About the Cancer Cachexia Society

The Cancer Cachexia Society (www.cancercachexiasociety.org) is an international, multidisciplinary organization dedicated to improving awareness, understanding, prevention, and management of cancer cachexia through research, education, collaboration, and advocacy. Education is central to the Society's mission, and the **Education Committee** plays a key role in advancing high-quality educational initiatives for clinicians, researchers, and trainees worldwide.

Role Overview

The Cancer Cachexia Society invites applications for **two new members** to join its Education Committee. This committee is responsible for developing and supporting educational activities that align with the Society's mission and strategic goals. This role is intended for individuals who demonstrate a strong commitment to the mission of the Cancer Cachexia Society and who are prepared to engage actively and consistently in committee activities. Applicants are expected to be current **regular or trainee members** of the Society.

Key Responsibilities:

- Actively support and promote the mission and educational objectives of the Cancer Cachexia Society
- Contribute to the planning, development, and evaluation of educational initiatives (e.g., webinars, courses, congress sessions, and educational resources)
- Attend regular (monthly) Education Committee meetings and participate constructively in discussions and decision-making
- Complete assigned tasks and contribute effort between meetings to advance committee projects
- Collaborate effectively with an international, multidisciplinary group of committee members and Society leadership
- Serve as an ambassador for the Society's educational activities within the broader scientific and clinical community

Expected Commitment:

- Demonstrated alignment with the mission and values of the Cancer Cachexia Society
- Strong expectation of regular attendance and active participation in committee meetings (up to 3 years)
- Willingness to dedicate sufficient time and effort to committee activities throughout the term of appointment

Qualifications

Applicants should meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Hold an MD or PhD degree
- Be a senior resident or postdoctoral fellow
- Be a junior or early-career faculty member

Additional desirable qualifications include:

- Background, expertise, or strong interest in cancer cachexia (clinical, translational, basic, or allied fields)
- Demonstrated interest in education, training, or knowledge dissemination
- Ability to work collaboratively in an international and multidisciplinary environment
- Strong communication skills, professionalism, and reliability

Term of Appointment:

Committee members are appointed **for up to 3 years**, with potential for renewal based on engagement, performance, and committee needs.

The anticipated start date is **October 2026**.
